

## HEPATITIS C

There are **TWO TESTS** to diagnose hepatitis C:

### 1) ANTIBODY TEST:

Tells you if you have ever been exposed to hepatitis C.



### 2) RNA TEST:

Tells you if you are currently infected with hepatitis C.



If your RNA TEST result is positive:

Talk to your healthcare provider about medication to **CURE** your hepatitis C infection!

Hepatitis C is a virus that attacks the liver. It is spread when blood from a person living with hep C enters the bloodstream of an uninfected person.
